

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has appropriated the sum of \$4900.00 in its 1966-67 budget to pay the salary of a water and sewer project foreman in accordance with an agreement with the U. S. Public Health Service and this amount was computed based on an hourly rate of \$2.13, and


WHEREAS, the incumbent in this position, Mr. Carlos Nosie, regularly operates various type of mechanized equipment at an hourly rate far below that of regular operators of such equipment, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council to rectify this inequity.

BE IT RESOLVED that the hourly rate paid to the incumbent of this position be raised to \$3.00 per hour and further that the sum of \$1500.00 be appropriated from savings in other areas of the Tribal Budget and transferred to Section VIII, Account 01-24-7931.

The foregoing resolution was on September 20, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
