WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it is necessary to have an anti-poverty program Personnel Selection Committee whose membership shall not be related to Community Action Program employees, and


WHEREAS, the Council has considered the qualifications of the four members selected for said committee, and


WHEREAS, each of them excel in his business or profession.

BE IT RESOLVED that Neal Hall, LeRoy Huddleston, Wayne Kirkpatrick and Hal Booher are hereby appointed to constitute the anti-poverty program Personnel Selection Committee under the Community Action Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Neal Hall shall serve as Chairman for a one year term commencing the 19th day of October, 1966 and ending October 19, 1967; LeRoy Huddleston shall be appointed for a two year term beginning the 19th day of October, 1966 and expiring on the 19th day of October, 1968; that Wayne Kirkpatrick shall serve for a three year period beginning October 19, 1966 and ending October 19, 1969 and that Hal Booher is hereby appointed for a four year term beginning October 19, 1966 and ending October 19, 1970.

The foregoing resolution was on October 19, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
