WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, due to the cut-back in the Neighborhood Youth Corps Program, a greater number of teen-age students had to be helped to go back to school, and


WHEREAS, the continuing Headstart Program accepted a greater number of students who also had to be helped to start school, and


WHEREAS, these problems had not been anticipated in preparing this year's budget, resulting in the tribal welfare accounts being expended early, and

WHEREAS, there is a continuing need for welfare funds to help needy children and adults.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$1,400.00 is hereby appropriated to increase the welfare section of the budget, said sum to be transferred from savings within the total budget for FY 1966-67.

The foregoing resolution was on October 19, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
