

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has continued to provide recreation lakes, campgrounds and facilities at no cost to the general public, and

WHEREAS, the cost of maintenance, litter removal and game management has increased each year, and

WHEREAS, there has not been an increase in the general fishing and hunting permit fees during the past five years.

BE IT RESOLVED that the following Fort Apache Reservation fishing and hunting fee schedule be established to become effective January 1, 1967.

DAY FISHING PERMITS: \$0.75 for the first day and \$0.50 for each additional day.

SEASON (YEAR) FISHING PERMITS: Persons living on the Reservation six months or longer - \$5.00
 All others \$15.00

HUNTING PERMITS:

Elk	\$30.00
Antelope	25.00
Non-member Guide Permit	25.00
Non-Member Hunting Dog Permit	25.00
Bear	10.00
Predatory Animals	5.00
Javelina	3.00
Dove & Waterfowl	3.00
Quail	2.00

BOAT FEES, required only on lakes where the Tribe operates boat rental concessions - \$0.75 per day or \$5.00 for full year.

The foregoing resolution was on October 19, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
