WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Council has received innumerable complaints as to the operation of the Apache Flame, and

WHEREAS, the Apache Flame operation lost some \$2,000.00 in the past three months.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Apache Flame shall be hereafter be open for business on the following days and during the following hours, to-wit:

Tuesday	4:00 p. m. to 12:00 p.m.
Wednesday	4:00 p.m. to 12:00 p.m.
Thursday	4:00 p.m. to 12:00 p.m.
Friday	4:00 p.m. to 12:00 p.m.
Saturday	12:00 noon to 1:00 a.m.

The foregoing resolution was on November 2, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
