

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the education of the Indian children on the reservation is of a prime importance to the welfare of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and



WHEREAS, Elementary School District No. 20, Navajo County, Arizona has requested a lease of additional land on the reservation for the purpose of constructing an additional classrooms and apartments. Said land be contiguous to the Seven Mile School premises.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is authorized for and on behalf of the Tribe to execute a 25 year gratuitous lease beginning July 1, 1960 with an option to renew for an additional 25 years with the Elementary School District No. 20, Navajo County, Arizona for the construction of classrooms and apartments on said site.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the area being leased is located on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Section 36, Township 5 North, Range 22 East, G. & S.R.B. & M., Navajo County, Arizona; thence run South  $33^{\circ} 41' 30''$  West 1,098.64 feet to an iron pin, the True Point of Beginning; thence run North  $85^{\circ} 21' 50''$  West 252.20 feet to an iron pin; thence run South  $02^{\circ} 10' 20''$  East 622.24 feet to an iron pin; thence run South  $57^{\circ} 41' 30''$  East 80.85 feet to an iron pin; thence run South  $65^{\circ} 26' 50''$  East 152.23 feet to an iron pin; thence run North  $70^{\circ} 40' 10''$  East 145.01 feet to an iron pin; thence run South  $85^{\circ} 05' 00''$  East 100.85 feet to an iron pin; thence run North  $17^{\circ} 55' 50''$  West 702.65 feet to the True Point of Beginning, and comprising an area of 5.25 acres.

The foregoing resolution was on November 2, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
