FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the value of stumpage has steadily increased, and

WHEREAS, the proportionate volume of timber sales which may be approved by the designated Approving Officer has decreased.


BE IT RESOLVED that authority be delegated to the Superintendent to enter into a timber contract for \$1,000.00 or less, with approval of the Tribal Council for advertised sales.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that authority be delegated to the Area Director to approve timber sales up to 50 MM board feet.

The foregoing resolution was on December 8, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
