WHEREAS, Hal Butler and Charles Montgomery desire to construct a hangar at the airport site, and


WHEREAS, the Tribe is contemplating in the future to purchase an airplane, and


WHEREAS, a hangar is necessary in order to protect the planes that will be based at the airport.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized and directed to sign a six (6) year lease on Lease Form 5-181, beginning on the 15th day of December, 1966, and ending on the 14th day of December, 1972.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the rental fee should be the appraised value of the land.

The foregoing resolution was on December 8, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
