WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Probate Fund is now exhausted, and

WHEREAS, it is vitally necessary that this tribal function be continuously operated.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the U. S. Treasury the sum of \$200.00 to defray the cost of the Probate Department for the remainder of the year.

The foregoing resolution was on December 20, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
