

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Elementary School District No. 20, Navajo County, Whiteriver, Arizona, desires to lease an area approximating 2.08 acres on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for the purpose of constructing school facilities thereon, and

WHEREAS, the Council is cognizant of the importance of education of the Apache children, and

WHEREAS, there are some conflicting leases and/or resolutions regarding the said area of land.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to sign for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe a 25 year gratuitous lease with a 25 year option, said lease being with the Elementary School District No. 20, Navajo County, Whiteriver, Arizona in covering the following described premises:

Commencing at the quarter corner common to Sections 12 and 13, Township 5 North, Range 22 East, G. & S.R.B. & M., Navajo County, Arizona; thence run South 61°06'00" East 809.70 feet to an axle; thence run South 66°19'40" East 127.50 feet to an iron pin, the True Point of Beginning; thence continue South 66°19'40" East 100.00 feet to an iron pin; thence run North 27°26'50" East 218.56 feet to an iron pin; thence run South 66°17'50" East 56.48 feet to an iron pin; thence run North 23°42'10" East 265.15 feet to an iron pin; thence run North 75°15'20" West 272.08 feet to an iron pin; thence run South 27°29'30" West 232.38 feet to an iron pin; thence run South 62°34'40" East 126.81 feet to an iron pin; thence run South 27°27'20" West 201.27 feet to the True Point of Beginning, and comprising an area of 2.08 acres.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any and all resolutions in conflict with this resolution covering the said area of land are hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on January 4, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
