WHEREAS, Frank H. Cassell has dedicated much of his life to helping people, and




WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council is of the opinion that he is one of the most outstanding American Citizens, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council would be honored for having a man of the caliber of Mr. Frank H. Cassell as an honorary member of its Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED that Frank H. Cassell is hereby made an honorary member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of Indians of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, Whiteriver, Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on January 30, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
