

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Freddie Riley has been a Commissioned Deputy Sheriff since June of 1966, and

WHEREAS, he has received no pay for this work, and

WHEREAS, he has used his own automobile in transporting prisoners from McNary to Holbrook and Whiteriver.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from Tribal funds on deposit with the U. S. Treasury the sum of \$150.00 to be paid to Freddie Riley for reimbursement of travel expenses in transporting prisoners.

The foregoing resolution was on January 30, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
