FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, many of the Police Department's vehicles are worn out, and


WHEREAS, it is necessary that the said police department have mechanically sound rolling patrol cars.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from Tribal Funds on deposit in the U. S. Treasury the sum of \$6330.00 to purchase the following vehicles:

One Ford 100 Pickup with steel box	\$2430.00
One Custom sedan	1950.00
One Custom sedan	<u>1950.00</u>

The foregoing resolution was on January 30, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
