

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Arizona Highway Department has requested a gravel permit for use on the improvement of the Whiteriver-Indian Pine Highway #73.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman and Superintendent are hereby authorized and directed to grant a permit to the Arizona Highway Department to remove materials from the following material site located within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in close proximity to Highway 73:



The SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$, of Section 5, Township 6 North, Range 23 East, G&SRM, Navajo County, Arizona, together with a 50 foot wide haul road as indicated on the map on file at the Fort Apache Agency.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Arizona Highway Department pay the Tribe the following rates computed on a tonnage basis for the removal of said material:

Three (3¢) per ton for all borrow; Six cents (6¢) per ton for all Select, ABC, MA; and Ten cents (10¢) per ton for all Screenings

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a condition of approval of this application be that the Arizona Highway Department clean up all debris from the excavation of the operation and where overburden has been stocked to respread this overburden over the excavation area and reseed the area in accordance with recommendations from the technicians of the Branch of Land Operations, Fort Apache Indian Agency.

The foregoing resolution was on January 30, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
