

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, many positions such as Policemen, Game Wardens, Money Messengers and others require that Tribal employees carry firearms to protect persons and property, and

WHEREAS, employees in such positions and carrying weapons, must use extreme caution not to endanger other employees and other persons, and

WHEREAS, the use of said firearms by Tribal employees in the commission of a crime or the willful misuse of said firearms cannot be tolerated and the reputation and good name of the White Mountain Apache Tribe must be protected.

BE IT RESOLVED that any Tribal employee who uses a firearm or other weapon in the commission of a crime is automatically suspended or discharged.

The foregoing resolution was on January 30, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
