

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Wayne Kirkpatrick has been an honest and fair trader on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for 25 years, and

WHEREAS, he has actively promoted and participated in the Cedar Creek Pow-wow for many years, and

WHEREAS, he gives free of his time in trying to make the Cedar Creek Community a better place in which to live, and

WHEREAS, he is one of the few white persons on the reservation who was interested enough in the Apaches to learn their language, and


WHEREAS, he is an outstanding family man, and

WHEREAS, he has high morals and potentials.

BE IT RESOLVED that Wayne Kirkpatrick is hereby made an honorary member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that he be granted a free hunting and fishing permit and that he be allowed to kill one deer each year, one turkey each year and one elk every three years.

The foregoing resolution was on January 30, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 5 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
