

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council that all employees of the White Mountain Apache Tribe who are employed in the same capacity and doing the same type of work should be reimbursed for this work at the same rate of pay regardless of which department of the Tribe or Enterprise of the Tribe they are employed by, and

WHEREAS, a committee appointed by the Council has presented to the Council a proposed wage scale based on this theory, and


WHEREAS, the proposed wage scale also brings Tribal wages in line with those wages paid for similar skills within the surrounding areas based on a wage survey conducted.

BE IT RESOLVED that the proposed wage scale attached to this resolution be adopted for all employees of the White Mountain Apache Tribe effective 1 May, 1967.

The foregoing resolution was on March 1, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
