

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Diamond Creek No. 4 Logging Unit Contract, No. 14-20-0450-5845, approved by the Area Director, October 11, 1965 between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Fort Apache Timber Company does not provide for sample scaling, and

WHEREAS, a sample scaling plan has been approved that will provide statistically accurate results, and is in accordance with Fort Apache Timber Company scaling procedures, and

WHEREAS, the sample scaling program will insure efficiency and effect cost reduction, yet produce acceptable accuracy.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sample scaling system as approved by the Commissioner be used to determine log volumes for the Diamond Creek No. 4 Logging Unit.

The foregoing resolution was on March 20, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
