

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Branch of Roads is prohibited by Title 25 Code of Federal Regulations from maintaining roads on the reservation which are not a part of the Bureau Roads System, and

WHEREAS, local use of the Seven Mile - Stago Curve road has grown to the point that at least minimal maintenance is required.

BE IT RESOLVED that the following reservation road be added to the Bureau Road System on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on April 5, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
