

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Mr. Amadeo Michael Rea of the St. John's Indian School has requested permission to collect certain non-game species on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in connection with school zoology studies, and

WHEREAS, White Mountain Apache and other Indian students will participate and benefit educationally from these collection activities, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to cooperate with the St. John's Indian School in these studies.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and the Recreation Enterprise Manager be authorized to issue short term permits during the remainder of the calendar year as are requested by the school.

The foregoing resolution was on April 5, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
