RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution Nos. 64-125, 65-11 and 67-44 the Diamond Creek Timber Company has been operating the old Petersen Sawmill and leasing from the tribe approximately 8.44 acres of land, and

WHEREAS, the present lessee, Diamond Creek Timber Company, has sold all of its interest in and to said sawmill and the lease thereof to the A. J. Hurst Lumber Company, and

WHEREAS, the said A. J. Hurst Lumber Company desires a new five-year lease of said land.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized and directed to sign a five-year lease with A. J. Hurst Lumber Company covering approximately 8.44 acres of land, a plot of said land and the description thereof being on file in the Superintendent's Office, Fort Apache Indian Agency.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said company pay as and for rental fees for said land the sum of \$50.00 per acre or major fraction thereof annually in advance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the well and all personal property attached to the realty at the termination of this lease, for any reason, shall revert to the Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said land being leased shall be fenced and a cattle guard installed thereon, pursuant to specifications as provided by the Superintendent for the Fort Apache Indian Agency.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that before said lease is signed by the Chairman that a termination of lease agreement be entered into by and between the Tribe and the Diamond Creek Lumber Company.

The foregoing resolution was on April 19, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
