

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Timber Company has requested that it be permitted to log an area adjacent to the Elk Canyon Logging Unit, and

WHEREAS, the mill is in need of logs from an area off of the present units they have subsidiary timber sale under contract.

BE IT RESOLVED in order to meet this specific emergency an exception be granted in Section B-4 of the Plan of Operation for the Fort Apache Timber Company to permit the appraisal and stumpage rates to be determined concurrently with logging operations in this area.

The foregoing resolution was on April 19, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
