

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe have a large economic investment in the Community Action Program, and
- WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council to assure that the Community Action Program is run in an efficient manner so as to not only reflect credit upon the Tribe but also to ensure continued funding of Economic Programs in the future, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by unanimous vote in the meeting of January 30, 1967 authorized the Tribal Chairman to look into the Community Action Program and correct any adverse conditions he might find immediately, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Chairman has made an investigation into the management of the Community Action Program by the Director, Mr. Lester Oliver and it is his opinion that Mr. Oliver has failed to perform the duties of Director.

- BE IT RESOLVED that Mr. Lester Oliver is hereby removed as Director of the Community Action Program and that Mr. Raymond Kane who is the current Assistant Community Action Director be promoted to the position of Director, White Mountain Apache Community Action Program as recommended by the Community Action Advisory Committee.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Billy Kane be offered an appointment as Assistant Director of the Community Action Program to replace the position vacated by Mr. Raymond Kane.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appointment of the new Director and Assistant Director be effective immediately.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Tribal Resolution No. 66-53 pertaining to the appointment of Lester Oliver and Raymond Kane to Community Action Program positions is hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on April 19, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 2 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 934).
