

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 67-76 the Tribe requested that the Bureau of Indian Affairs cooperate with it by appointing an arbitration board to make a study of the marking practices of the Bureau of Indian Affairs in the Fort Apache Timber Company timber block, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to rescind said Resolution No. 67-76 and provide for a study committee instead of a Board of Arbitration to review and study the marking practices of the Bureau not only on the Fort Apache Timber Company block but on all active timber sales.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the United States Treasury the sum of \$2,500.00 to defray the cost of employing the services of a forestry expert to study the marking methods and application of these methods of the Forestry Branch of the Bureau of Indian Affairs.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Hal Butler, Fort Apache Timber Company Manager, is to appoint said expert to serve on the study committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs is hereby requested to appoint an expert on the study committee and that these two experts shall appoint a third member of the study committee and that the Bureau of Indian Affairs and Fort Apache Timber Company is hereby requested to abide by the recommendations of said study committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the two experts, one appointed by Fort Apache Timber Company and one appointed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, are unable to agree on the other member of the committee that each of them shall submit one name to the Tribal Council Chairman and the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency for their selection.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 67-76 is hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on May 3, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
