

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Elementary School District No. 20, Whiteriver, Arizona, pursuant to U. S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare, Office of Education Bulletin No. 75, dated January 20, 1967, does hereby desire to initiate a request to have the federally-owned school facility, known as the Whiteriver Elementary School transferred to school ownership, and


WHEREAS, the present Whiteriver Elementary facility is the property of the Office of Education, Department of Health, Education and Welfare, and


WHEREAS, in order to transfer ownership from the Office of Education to the Elementary School District No. 20 the site must be released by the Office of Education and leased to the Elementary School District No. 20.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby requests that the Office of Education of the Department of Health, Education and Welfare release the site on which the Whiteriver Elementary School is located.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the site is to be re-leased to the Board of Trustees, Elementary School District No. 20.

The foregoing resolution was on July 18, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
