

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Paradise Creek Logging Unit is included in the five years Timber Sale Program, and

WHEREAS, timber from this unit is part of the Allowable Annual Cut.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Paradise Creek Logging Unit as presented in the Forest Officers Report and Proposed Contract covering the recommended sale of this timber and subject to minor changes and Administrative adjustments by the Approving Officer, be sold at the following rates per thousand board feet.

Ponderosa pine	6,704	\$16.25	\$12.00
Douglas-fir	3,724	13.65	10.00


plus \$2.68 per M bd. ft. for Road deposit.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a deduction of fifty per cent (50%) of the value of the timber cut and scaled shall be made until such time as a total value of \$40,000.00 has been accrued. This money shall be used to construct a Class III road as stated in the Proposed Paradise Creek Forest Officers Report & Contract.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should the Fort Apache Timber Company not elect to purchase this sale that it can be advertised at the above stumpage rates and under conditions covered in the proposed Forest Officers Report and Contract subject to such minor changes and administrative adjustments by the Approving Officer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary are authorized to execute the contract and related documents necessary to administer the sale of the timber for and on behalf of this council.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
