FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribe had previously endorsed the building of Geronimo Trail Road, and


WHEREAS, there is a probability that this Geronimo Trail Road project will be funded in the year 1970, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe is most anxious that said road be completed as soon as possible.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Bureau is hereby requested to make application for funds and do all the necessary engineering work to ensure that if and when funds are available for the construction of the Geronimo Trail Road that the said construction will proceed without delay.

The foregoing resolution was on September 6, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
