

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Office of Economic Opportunity only allowed sufficient funds to enroll one hundred fifty (150) Head Start children, and

WHEREAS, there are twenty (20) additional children in the five-year old classification which need the Head Start Training, and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to offer all the educational advantages possible to its children.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the U. S. Treasury the sum of \$9,025.00 to defray the cost of enrolling and training twenty (20) five-year old children in the Head Start Program.

The foregoing resolution was on September 6, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
