

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, a non-profit corporation known as G.G.A.N.G. has been formed to provide legal aid services for Gila, Graham, Apache, Navajo, San Carlos and Fort Apache Indian Reservations, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe will have to provide its pro rata share of in kind services on funds.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council shall upon the approval of a legal aid program for the reservation furnish office space, an interpreter as its in kind contribution.

The foregoing resolution was on September 6, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
