


RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the firm of Rod Gomez and Associates has presented to the White Mountain Apache Tribe a final set of plans and specifications for the construction of a Neighborhood Facility in Whiteriver, and

WHEREAS, it is the feeling of the Tribal Council that the plans and specifications as submitted are adequate to fulfill the requirements for such a facility.

BE IT RESOLVED that the final plans and specifications as presented by Mr. Gomez are approved for construction of the Whiteriver Neighborhood Facility.

The foregoing resolution was on October 18, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
