FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the employees of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in its enterprise have found it difficult, in the past, to obtain credit from commercial banking institution, and


WHEREAS, this lack of credit has created hardships as well as being very costly for the members, and

WHEREAS, if the Tribal employees were able to authorize deductions from tribal pay checks directly to a commercial banking institution, it would be much easier for them to obtain loans at standard rates of interest.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Business Office is authorized to accept requests for payroll deductions from employees of the Tribe to the First National Bank of Arizona, Pinetop, Arizona Branch.

The foregoing resolution was on November 1, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
