

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is vitally interested in developing the tourism and recreation potential of the reservation area known as Sunrise Park, and

WHEREAS, the funds for developing an integrated recreation complex are available from the Economic Development Administration.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council authorizes an application for development funds to EDA for the proper development of Sunrise Park.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the portion of Resolution No. 66-28 which pertained to an EDA application for funds to develop a ski area at Mount Ord, be rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on November 14, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1953, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
