

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on July 1, 1967, Webb C. and Maxine Gregg and the White Mountain Apache Tribe entered in a lease covering the Hon-Dah Restaurant and amended on September 12, 1967, and


WHEREAS, the lessee is in default by not furnishing a performance bond and paying the monthly rental as provided for in the lease.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the lease with Webb C. and Maxine Gregg is hereby terminated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Manager of the White Mountain Apache Enterprises is authorized and directed to retain an operator on a month to month temporary basis until more satisfactory arrangements can be made and that at the discretion of the Manager, monthly rentals may be waived until May 1, 1968.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the operator keep the restaurant open weekends; closing on Monday or Tuesday; open hours from 6:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M.; maintain all equipment in the restaurant; and pay all utilities; namely, electricity and butane.

The foregoing resolution was on December 6, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
