FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, George Gregg uses his own private automobile while working for the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, no funds were set up for expenses of this type in his position.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Budget for Fiscal Year 1967-68 approved by Resolution No. 67-69 is hereby amended to provide for funds in the sum of \$300.00 to defray the automobile expenses of the incumbent of the position now held by George Gregg in the Tribal Recreational Department while on official business.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Administrative Manager is hereby directed to effectuate a savings within the Tribal Budget fund to the items within the budget.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
