

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 67-114, Edward Barr was granted a twenty five (25) year traders lease to operate a canteen in the community of Cibecue, and

WHEREAS, the said Edward Barr now desires to operate a small grocery store in conjunction with the canteen.


BE IT RESOLVED that permission is hereby granted to Mr. Edward Barr to operate a small grocery store in conjunction with the canteen at Cibecue, Arizona.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said Edward Barr pay the additional sum of \$125.00 to the Tribe for operating said grocery store.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Edward Barr not sell any other items except grocery items and that he specifically not sell any hardware goods or service station items.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 67-114 is hereby amended to incorporate the above changes.

The foregoing resolution was on January 3, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
