

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 65-23 granted permits to the Arizona Highway Department to remove sand and gravel from various material sites on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, these permits terminated on December 31, 1967, and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Highway Department has need of a material site for further construction on the Globe-Show Low Highway, Corduroy Canyon section, and


WHEREAS, the Arizona Highway Department has requested an extension of five years to December 31, 1972 of the permit to an area in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 33, Township 9 North, Range 21 East, G&SRM, Arizona.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman and Superintendent are hereby authorized and directed to grant a permit to the Arizona Highway Department covering the above-described area for a period of five years ending December 31, 1972.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Arizona Highway Department pay the tribe the following rates computed on a tonnage basis for the removal of said sand and gravel, to wit:

Five cents (5¢) per ton for all borrow; ten cents (10¢) per ton for all select, ABC, MA; and fifteen cents (15¢) per ton for all screenings.

The foregoing resolution was on January 3, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
