FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the old Cibecue Day School facilities are needed to house the Head Start students, and


WHEREAS, the old central heating is inadequate and too obsolete to repair, and

WHEREAS, the sum of \$740.00 is needed to purchase heaters.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the U. S. Government, the sum of \$740.00 to purchase heaters for the Cibecue Head Start Classrooms.

The foregoing resolution was on January 3, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
