

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Office of Economic Opportunity Program expected to receive an allocation of funds several weeks ago, and

WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States has appropriated funds for the Office of Economic Opportunity, subsequently approved by the President of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Indian Desk, Jim Wilson, by telephone this date, advised that the funds had been approved and further that the extension and refunding of all Office of Economic Opportunity Programs on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation had been approved by the Office of Economic Opportunity, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Office of Economic Opportunity are approximately \$15,000.00 in deficit as of this date with another payroll due on January 12, 1968 of approximately the same amount, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Wilson advised that funds most likely would be available within a period of two weeks, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jim Wilson further advised that funds could be reimbursed to the tribe from Office of Economic Opportunity funds when received.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$50,000.00 on deposit in the Treasurer of the United States to the credit of the White Mountain Apache Tribe be hereby appropriated for use by the White Mountain Apache Office of Economic Opportunity.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED on receipt of Office of Economic Opportunity funds, the total amount will be reimbursed to the general account of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on January 10, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
