

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolutions No. 66-26, 67-124 and 67-151 all deal with an application to the Department of Housing and Urban Development for a community building to be placed in Whiteriver, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 67-151 approved the final plans and specifications as presented by Gomez and Associates for construction of the Whiteriver Neighborhood Facility, and

WHEREAS, bids were let for construction but all bids exceeded the allocation of funds plus the Tribe's contribution by one-third, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe requested Gomez and Associates to revise the specifications and resubmit to Housing and Urban Development for approval, and

WHEREAS, these revisions have submitted and approved by the San Francisco Office of Housing and Urban Development.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby authorized to approve such revised plans and specifications as submitted, after due consultation with the technical committee appointed to review the plans of the Neighborhood Facility.

The foregoing resolution was on February 7, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
