


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN JAPACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Deer Spring Canyon Logging Unit Contract No. 14-20-0450-5334 was purchased by the Cibecue Lumber Company and assigned to Western Pine Sales, Incorporated on December 20, 1967, and
- WHEREAS, the contract established the sale boundary in the northwestern portion of the unit to coincide with the location of the Dry Ridge Road, extending from the Rim Road south into section 19, T10N,R18, and
- WHEREAS, the Dry Ridge Road is located along the center of a ridge excluding that timber west of the road from the Deer Spring Unit, and
- WHEREAS, the excluded timber is isolated from the next timber sale west of Deer Spring Canyon by cliffs and rocky bluffs, and
- WHEREAS, this volume of timber, approximating 200,000 bf. could be cut under the Deer Spring Canyon Logging Unit more economically, and without any loss to the tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED that based on the above it is requested that the Approving Officer modify, the said Deer Spring Canyon Logging Unit to include the additional area and timber.

The foregoing resolution was on February 7, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
