

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Cibecue No. 1 Logging Unit Contract No. 14-20-0450-5026 was purchased by the Reidhead and Chlarson Lumber Company Incorporated on August 14, 1964 and was assigned to Western Pines Sales, In Incorporated on December 20, 1967, and

WHEREAS, the Reidhead and Chlarson Lumber Company, Incorporated failed to meet their minimum cutting requirements in contract years 1964 through 1967 accruing a total cutting deficit of 11,367,020 board feet at the end of the 1967 contract year - December 31, 1967, and

WHEREAS, Western Pine Sales, Incorporated has requested relief from this cutting and paying deficit, and


WHEREAS, Western Pine Sales, Incorporated has shut down the Cibecue Sawmill for extensive renovation and repair so it can sustain a higher production rate in the future that will provide continuous employment and stumpage receipts, and

WHEREAS, the 1967 Tribal Budget is primarily based on the anticipated revenue from forest products, and

WHEREAS, if the sum of \$40,000.00 is lost to the Tribe, there will be a great hardship on the Apache people.


BE IT RESOLVED that based on the above facts it is requested the Approving Officer not grant Western Pine Sales, Incorporated, relief of the cutting and paying requirements for the 1967 cutting deficit.

The foregoing resolution was on February 7, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
