


RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Hal Butler, the General Manager of the Fort Apache Timber Company a wholly owned tribal enterprise of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, desires to bid on Defense General Supply Contracts to furnish and/or deliver lumber and wood products requirements offered by the Defense General Supply Central Director of Procurement and Production, Richmond, Virginia, and

WHEREAS, the authority to submit bids is required by the Director of Procurement and Production.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mr. Hal Butler, Manager of the Fort Apache Timber Company, P. O. Box 797, Whiteriver, Arizona is hereby authorized to sign and submit any and all bids he deems to be to the benefit of the Fort Apache Timber Company and the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on February 7, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
