

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Act of August 6, 1956 (70 Stat. 1057) authorizes the Secretary of the Interior to convey to any Indian Tribe, upon their request, title to any federally-owned building, improvement or facility located on Indian land that is no longer required by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and
- WHEREAS, a new school facility has been constructed and occupied by the Bureau of Indian Affairs in the village of Cibecue, Arizona, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council and members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in the Cibecue area have expressed a desire to obtain the surplus buildings known as the old Cibecue Day School, and
- WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Tribal Council that there is a need for a Youth Center, Headstart Classrooms, and a Health Center in the Cibecue area, and
- WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Agency plans to dispose of the surplus buildings at Cibecue.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe requests Bureau of Indian Affairs buildings Numbers 301-School Building; 302-Cottage; 303-Triplex; 304-Garage; 305-Water Tank and Storage; 306-Garage; 307-Kitchen-Dining room; 309-Power & Pump House; 311-Laundry; 312-Storage Building; 334-Warehouse; Electrical Distribution System; Sewer System; and Water System be conveyed to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe accepts responsibility for adequate maintenance and proper utilization of said buildings and realizes that the Secretary of the Interior should he determine that the property is not being adequately maintained or properly utilized by the White Mountain Apache Tribe, or that the property creates a health or safety hazard, may declare a forfeiture of the transfer of title in which conveyed, the property shall revert to the United States.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized to sign any and all documents necessary to effectuate the above transfer and leases.

The foregoing resolution was on February 7, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (j) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
