FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Office mimeograph machine is obsolete and in need of extensive repairs, and

WHEREAS, because of the Tribal Election on April 3, 1968, it requires a great deal of mimeographing.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from funds on deposit in the treasury, the sum of \$778.00 to purchase a Gestetner, Model No. 366, Duplicating machine.

The foregoing resolution was on March 6, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
