FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Western Pine Sales, Inc., assignee of the Cibecue No. 1 Logging Unit, Contract No. 14-20-0450-5026, has requested that the remaining volume from the Cibecue No. 1 Logging Unit be sample scaled, and


WHEREAS, the sample scaling system now in use at the Fort Apache Timber Company would be readily adaptable at the Cibecue sawmill, and

WHEREAS, the accuracy of sampling at the Fort Apache Timber Company has been acceptable and would be even more accurate at Cibecue because fewer species of timber are involved.

BE IT RESOLVED that a sample scaling procedure acceptable to the Purchase and the Branch of Forestry be implemented at the Cibecue sawmill. Also, that the Tribal Chairman and the Tribal Secretary are authorized to execute the necessary documents.

The foregoing resolution was on March 6, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
