

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Economic Development Administration has been asked for funds with which to build an access road and bridge to more directly link Fort Apache Timber Company with State Highway 173, and

WHEREAS, this project would be a combination funding involving a grant in the amount of \$261,212.00 an "in-kind" contribution of \$2,500.00 and a long-term interest loan in the amount of \$62,803.00.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe is authorized to contract with the Economic Development Administration for repayment of the \$62,803.00 loan portion of the project. This sum would approximate \$3,700.00 per annum.

The foregoing resolution was on March 6, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
