

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, through inadvertence the Council failed to provide funds to conduct the April, 1968 Tribal Election, and

WHEREAS, the cost of this election was the sum of \$1048.00

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$1048.00 to defray the cost of the 1968 Tribal Election. Said sum to be secured from any savings effectuated in the 1967-68 Tribal Budget.

The foregoing resolution was on April 4, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
