FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Joe Dora has provided invaluable assistance and made many contributions to the Tribe as a member of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Board of Directors, and

WHEREAS, the present Board has recommended that the Council reappoint Mr. Joe Dora to the Board for a three-year period beginning May 1, 1968 and ending May 1, 1971, and

WHEREAS, the Council has accepted this recommendation.

BE IT RESOLVED that Joe Dora is hereby appointed for a three-year term as a member of the Board of Directors of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise in accordance with the provision of the Plan of Operation of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise.

The foregoing resolution was on May 1, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
