


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Neal Hall's term as a member of the Personnel Selection Committee of the Anti-Poverty Committee has expired, and

WHEREAS, the Council feels that Don Pogue would be well qualified to serve on the said Committee.

BE IT RESOLVED that Don Pogue is hereby appointed as a member of the Anti-Poverty Program Personnel Selection Committee for a four-year term beginning October, 1967 and ending October, 1972.

The foregoing resolution was on May 1, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
