


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Alchesay High School District No. 20 has made application through the Tribe for an additional fifteen (15) acres of land, and

WHEREAS, after an investigation, the Council feels that the additional acreage is needed for future expansion of the school, including but, without limitation, establishment of a Junior High School, additional housing for the teachers and additional area for the garages.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is hereby authorized for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to sign a twenty five (25) year gratuitous lease together with a twenty five (25) year option covering fifteen (15) acres of ground adjacent to the present school premises with the Alchesay High School District No. 20, the lease of said fifteen (15) acres being on file with the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency to which reference is hereby made.

The foregoing resolution was on May 1, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
